- Late entries at the discretion of the Field Trial Secretary if the trial is under subscribed
- The draw will take place on **20<sup>th</sup> December 2021** at Dog Tree Bank Farm as above Entrants will be informed by e-mail or telephone.

### Rules and Regulations

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. The Working Clumber Spaniel Society shall reserve the right to refuse any entry.
3. Substitution of dogs may take place at the discretion of The Field Trial Secretary.
4. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to compete number before entry to the event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the competitor.
5. If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners the right to compete in a trial shall be decided by ballot.
6. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges may alter the arrangements, as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to The Kennel Club.
7. No modification shall be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
8. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.
9. Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express permission of the Chief Steward and the host.
10. Welfare of Dogs. A competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not knowingly put their dogs 'health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
11. If a competitor, or anyone in their household has COVID-19 related symptoms or has tested positive for Covid-19 they must not attend the event and should self-isolate in line with government advice.
